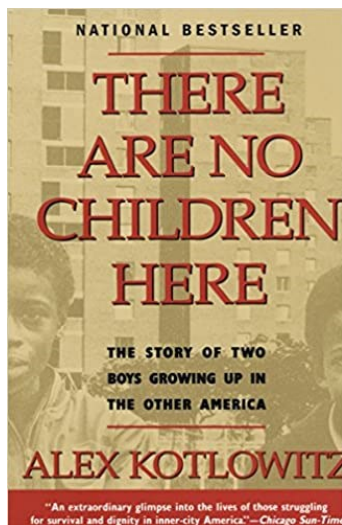


April 2022 Blue Bow Book Club: *There Are No Children Here*
